### REFLECTION

After making a name for himself in other towns and villages of Palestine as a teacher (Rabbi) with authority (Mark 1:22) and a miracle worker *extraordinaire*, Jesus finally went home to Nazareth, where he had been brought up. One would have expected his townspeople to welcome him triumphantly, but no, they were put off by him. They knew him too well because he had grown up among them.

He came from a poor home, with a carpenter as his (supposed) father and a simple village woman as his mother. None of his kin was special in any way, they were all so ordinary. Jesus himself did not have the benefit of a good education. He had attended none of the theological institutes that trained *rabbis*. His coming back home, to Nazareth to teach people about God and to work miracles, made them ask questions; Where did he get all that from? Who does he think he is? Here is a classic case of familiarity breeding contempt. He was outrightly rejected by his own people.

Jesus' experience of rejection in Nazareth renders him powerless to do any miracle among his own people. There are some members of our families, church, locality, and country who are equally facing and experiencing some form of rejection by families and friends, and they are broken and discouraged by this attitude towards them. Let us, see, and respect in everyone, the human dignity they deserve, the dignity of God fully human, fully Alive in every human being.
